Where will candidate videos be located? Candidate videos will be posted on the <u>Texas FFA</u> website, as well as the app, for voting delegates to view prior to voting.

## What do I do in case of an emergency?

If you find yourself in an emergency situation, you need to immediately contact your advisor, or any adult around you. In case of a medical emergency, the medic station will be set up and located in the concourse beside room 101. When will doors open to the convention center each day? The doors will open at 1 pm on Monday, July 11, and at 6:30 am on Thursday, July 14. For the remainder of the days, the doors will open at 7 am.
