



Below is a brief recap of action taken by the Texas FFA Board of Directors during the fourth quarter meeting which took place on Friday, June 6th, 2025 in Stephenville, Texas.

- Approved Minutes from the third quarter Board Meeting on April 6th, 2025.
- Approved the recommendation of new Texas FFA Board members.
- Approved Mr. Nathan Jordan to be the CDE Committee Co-Chair.
- Approved the 2025-26 budget as presented.
- Formed a committee to review recommendations from the State Leadership Conference (SLC) Committees.
- Approved 2796 Lone Star recipients and 250 Honorary Lone Star recipients for 2025.
- Approved the amendment to CDE Rule 19 to add “headphones” to the list of prohibited devices during contests.
- Approved the amendment to CDE Rule 30 that allows for a student to participate in only one area or state CDE per day.
- Approved the staff recommendation of Policy 26.2 confirming that all information submitted on degree and awards application is factual. Falsified information may result in ineligibility.
- Approved the staff recommendation of Policy 26.4 regarding requirements for the State (Lone Star) FFA Degree. With this change, students must have earned and/or invested \$1000. This is a change from the old language that stated students must have earned and productively invested.
- Approved 7 new chapter charters.
- Discussed the implications of National FFA’s plans to fully affiliate all members.
- Discussed the potential re-allocation of Texas FFA delegate representation.
